Living with Millboard

The beauty of Millboard, as well as its looks, is how little you have to do to keep it looking great. Its Lastane® surface is highly resistant to scratches, food and drink stains, and everyday use.

Here are a few simple maintenance tips:

- Remove spills and marks with just a mild detergent and a cloth or brush (no solvents, chemicals or abrasive cleaners needed). Strong dyes and stains that fall on your decking, such as berries and animal droppings, should not be left to prevent marking.
- Stubborn marks may be removed with household bleach. Always test in a small area first.
- Take care when moving sharp objects across your decking to avoid marking, e.g. unprotected table or chair legs, spiked shoes or metal planter bases.
- Use a small amount of granulated white salt (not rock salt) to tackle ice in the winter, and simply wash it off with soapy water and a soft broom once the weather warms up.
- And don't worry about painting, staining or treating your Millboard deck - it doesn't need it and never will!

That's all - now sit back and enjoy your outdoor space...Live.Life.Outside.
